• **Hrvatska državna vlast napada hrvatsko društvo**

Predsjednik Vlade i Republike, vrijeđaju Sud, svađe su unutar stranaka i među koalicijskim partnerima. Vlada vlada nad ljudima a ne za ljude. Istovremeno vladajući su ljudima nepoznati u svjetskoj i hrvatskoj javnosti, po bilo čemu drugom osim vladanjem i bahaćenjem. • **Hrvatska danas**

1. Holokaust se dogodio, Nacizam je srušen, Staljinizam, urušavanje SSSR-a, progon naroda u Jugoslaviji, srpska agresija, međunarodna intervencija. Totalitarizam je slijepa ulica, bez budućnosti.
2. Ljudi u društvu rade, imaju obitelj, idu u školu, brinu o zdravlju, čuvaju okolinu, razvijaju kulturu, druže se, surađuju, putuju u druge zemlje, primaju goste, vjeruju, uživaju sport, odmaraju se ... međusobno su razne dobi, spola, zanimanja, uvjerenja, iskazuju razlike ali i sposobnost komunikacija, poštovanja, suradnje.
3. U Hrvatskoj ljudi su nesigurni u pravu na djecu, zapošljavanje, rad, isplate plaća i ostajanje u zemlji. Ljudi su dovedeni u bijedu, nezaposlenost, zdvojnost. Ne znaju kako da si pomognu? Nijedan štrajk nije uspio! Nijedan protest seljaka! Stari se više ni ne usuđuju istupati. Branitelje se sudi, vrijeđa, koristi nasilje, kao na samom početku agresije. To se čini kada je međunarodni sud zaključio da je u Hrvatskoj udruženi zločin počinjen samo protiv Hrvatske i Hrvata, od strane Srbije, JNA i pobunjenih Srba. Hrvatska je desetljećima napadana, izdvajanje ustaštva u zlo iznad nacizma, neistinom o Jasenovcu i tajenjem Bleiburga. Još uvijek se ovdje ne usudi objaviti kako se postupalo sa Nijemcima i Židovima, nakon 1945.
4. Hrvatsko društvo je postalo društvo, velikog broja podjela, sukoba i stalno novog raspadanja. U sukobu je unutar sebe, sa susjedima i Evropskom unijom.
5. Hrvatska država i društvo ne uživaju poštovanje u svijetu, u Evropskoj uniji, unutar sebe, među političarima vlasti i oporbe, u akademskoj zajednici, među kulturnim radnicima i iznad svega u narodu. To je društvo sukoba, neistina, nerada, odlaska ... Hrvatska je konfliktno društvo koje propada.

6. U Hrvatskoj je odbačeno znanje, vjera, dobrota i nada. Ljudi znanja žive praktično u getima, svedeni na minimum rada u školovanju, međusobne rasprave, posjet i primanje kolega iz svijeta. Vlast ne koristi savjete, znanje, znanost. Tri godine zajedno sa Jastrebow opsežno smo upozoravali Predsjednika Republike, na opasnosti i što će se dogoditi, da radi krivo i nepravedno.

7. Kako sudjeluje HAZU, Sveučilišta, Matica Hrvatska ...

8. Zdravstveni radnici su poniženi, svećenike se vrijeđa. Hrvati u BiH su marginalizirani a iseljenici odbačeni.

9. Istovremeno Hrvatska može i treba biti uspješna država, u kojoj ljudi rade, imaju obitelji, slobodu i raduju se životu. Na svojem položaju, dostignutom razvoju i broju stanovnika, ako nekoliko miliona ljudi u Hrvatskoj ne mogu biti uspješni, onda ni Evropa nema šanse. Evropa je podijeljena na 100 miliona povlašćenih i 500 miliona socijalno ugroženih. Ovo je opet podjela ljudi, naroda i država, na bolje i gore. Ovo je krah Njemačke politike ravnopravnosti ljudi.

Već smo se u Vukovaru 1991 strogo podijelili. Na strani Srbije je ostalo ime države, vojska, novac, diplomacija, Ujedinjeni Narodi.
